**Bags (not food bags).**

- Large bags (shopping)
- Small bags (freezer/vegetable)
- Other types of bag. (specify)

**Household & recreation.**

- Bottles & containers (not food related)
- Toys, children's playthings & party accessories (e.g., balloons, stickers, party poppers)
- Household gloves (not surgical)

### **Smoking & vaping.**

- Cigarettes, stubs, filters and loose tobacco
- Lighters & cigarette / tobacco packaging (e.g., packets and papers)
- E-cigarettes & vaping products

### **Sanitary & medical.**

- Single use face masks
- Wet wipes
- Surgical gloves (disposable)
- Cotton bud sticks
- Personal hygiene products
- Baby products

### **Miscellaneous.**

- Packaging (including sheeting, film, bubble wrap)
- String, cord & rope
- Unidentifiable plastic & polystyrene pieces

### **Paper and Cardboard.**

- Cartons (e.g., milk and soft drink tetra Pak)
- Newspapers & magazines
- Tissues (note wet wipes are in sanitary and medical section)

### **Wood.**

- Cutlery
- Stirrers & lolly sticks
- Pieces of wood

### **Metal (note these may be in the food related section).**

- Aerosol & spray cans (not N02 cannisters – separate item)
- Disposable BBQs and associated components (not partyware)
- Other (specify)

### **Glass.**

- Bottles & containers (incl. pieces)
- Fragments less than 2.5 cm

### **Other.**

- Pollutants (wax, oil, grease)
- Pottery & ceramics
- Textiles (i.e., Clothing & fabrics)
- Bagged dog waste
- Bagged rubbish (bin bag)
- Bagged rubbish (shopping bag)
- Fireworks and associated components
