

# Park Improvement Project

Update January 20<sup>th</sup>

Poor weather has hampered some site works particularly around the sedimentation pond and reedbed however elsewhere on drier ground, works are progressing as planned. The children's play area is closed and work to remove the old equipment, and prepare for the installation of new equipment is well underway. A new bridge at the Pinner View entrance is also in place over Yeading Brook and this will ultimately be part of a new pedestrian entrance to the Park. Works to realign the Yeading Brook continue and the extension to the overflow from the Moat is in progress. The new footpath leading to Headstone Lane West is complete and is now open along with a new bench to sit and enjoy some winter sunshine!



With the felling of a large Weeping Willow tree, adjacent to the playground, plans for the de-culverting of the Brook at this point can continue. Options to leave the tree in place were investigated, this wasn't however possible and the work to open up the Yeading Brook will go ahead. This work will improve the aquatic environment and is a vital part of the flood alleviation project in the Park.
