

Headstone Manor Park

Latest Update – 30th September 2021

Wetland Area

This area is opened for public use, the wetlands themselves will be temporarily fenced with stock wire and post fencing to protect the new aquatic plants and to provide time for enable the wildflower / grass seed mix to establish. The footpaths provide a circular route around the wetland as well as a link into Harrow View West development, the Orchard and wider park.

Overflow Carpark

Works to the overflow carpark has been completed but will remain fenced off to allow the grass seed to establish. Further planting of shrubs and hedgerows will be undertaken in the Autumn. There will be opportunities for members of the public to participate in the planting activities (Details will be posted on our Website / Facebook page / Park notice boards).

Picnic Area

Several Trees will be planted in the Autumn these will provide much needed shade to the area during warm weather

Children's Playground

The Vandalised trees will be replaced in the Autumn and tree guards added for there protection

Yeading Brook

The FoHMP will be undertaking monthly inspections of the Yeading Brook and organising clean up days, this will include the removal of unwanted material from the Brook and vegetation control to allow natural daylighting (Details will be posted on our Website / Facebook page / Park notice boards).

Pinner View – Naturalisation

The works to this area is now been completed, the damaged trees will be replaced in the autumn.

Orchard

Over 160 Fruit trees have been planted and these will be maintained by the FoHMP in conjunction with Harrow Council, the area will be temporarily fenced off with signage explaining that this is to protect the trees whilst growing to maturity. We will be holding Fruit Picking Days in the future (Details will be posted on our Website / Facebook page / Park notice boards)

Headstone Lane Carpark

Works to this area have been completed.



Headstone Lane - Earth Mounds & Boulders

The installation of Earth Mounds & Boulders have now been completed and will prevent any unauthorised vehicle access to the Park along this boundary.

Parkside Way Entrance

This entrance is now open for public use. The FoHMP are working in conjunction with Harrow Council to develop the small area opposite the allotments into a quiet / tranquil space for park users. There will be opportunities for members of the public to participate in the planting activities (Details will be posted on our Website / Facebook page / Park notice boards).

Flood Alleviation Scheme

The majority of the landscaping works has now been completed with the remainder due for completion over the coming weeks.

Flood basin No.1 - The provision of a natural low flood flow channel from the bridge to the outlet to basin No.2 will be modified to add some contour and to take energy out of the channel when in flood, some boulders will also be installed to deflect flow, and create some margins. This area will be seeded with a Wetland & Wildflower grass mix,

Flood Basin No.2 has been seeded with Amenity Grass as this will be used as an additional Football pitch

These areas will remain fenced off to enable the seed to establish.

There will be opportunities for members of the public to participate in the planting activities (Details will be posted on our Website / Facebook page / Park notice boards).

Football Pitches - Expected Completion September 2022

The Football pitches have now been sand banded and seeded, (The new pitches should be available for the 2022/2023 Season)

The FoHMP will also be undertaking several Rewilding / Naturalisation projects across the Park, this will include the planting of Wildflowers / Bulbs, Stumperies / Log piles to enhance the Biodiversity in the Park (Details of how to get involved will be posted on our Website / Facebook Page / Park notice boards)
